August 1—11, 2016

Monday, August 1

Depart Little Rock for overnight flight to Rome.

Tuesday, August 2

Arrive at Rome FCO Airport at 7:15 AM local time and board our motor coach for a bus tour of the Eternal City, stops will include:

- The Tiber Island Church of St. Bartholomew
- Rome's Jewish Quarter
- The Tempio Maggiore di Roma, the largest Synagogue in Rome
- The Basilica of Santa Maria in Trastevere

We will then check-in to our rooms at the Cicerone Hotel. Leisure time for the rest of the day.

Wednesday, August 3

We begin the day by crossing the border into Vatican City for early morning Mass at St. Peter's Basilica and will spend the morning exploring.

Afternoon we will again board our motor coach and stops will include:

- The Church of the Gesù, Mother Church for the Society of Jesus (Jesuits)
- The Pantheon
- Largo di Torre Argentina Square
- Santa Maria sopra Minerva, the only Gothic church in Rome

Leisure time for the evening.

Thursday, August 4

Day trip to Assisi where we will walk in the footsteps of St Francis and St Claire.

Friday, August 5 - Feast of Our Lady of the Snows

Motor coach tour including:

- The Basilica of Santa Prassede
- Santa Maria Maggiore for the Solemn Pontifical Mass and the pioggia dei fiori (raining of petals)

Remainder of the day at leisure.

Saturday, August 6

Early morning Mass at St. Peter's Basilica and the rest of the day is currently unscheduled.

Sunday, August 7

Motor coach tour including:

- Porta Portese, the largest market in Rome
- Spanish Steps
- Trevi Fountain
- Piazza Navona
- The Coliseum and Forum
- Santa Maria in Aracoeli Basilica
- Mamertime Prison
- Mass at the Church of San Pietro in Vincoli (St. Peter in Chains)

Monday, August 8

Morning Mass at St. Peter's Basilica, then a tour of the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. We then will travel to the Papal Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls. Evening at leisure.

Tuesday, August 9

Early morning departure for our day-trip to Lanciano, Italy where we will celebrate Mass and visit the Eucharistic Miracle. Return to Rome in the evening.

Wednesday, August 10

Following early morning Mass at St. Peter's Basilica we board our motor coach to tour Christian Rome.

- The Papal Archbasilica of St. John in the Lateran
- The Scala Sancta (Holy Stairs)
- Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem housing the relics of the Passion of our Lord
- Basilica of San Clemente

Return to the hotel for a "Farewell to Rome" dinner.

Thursday, August 11

After breakfast we will begin our journey home to Arkansas.

About the dress code. St. Peter's Basilica and many of the Churches we will visit have a dress code. No shorts, no bare shoulders, no tank tops, bare back/midriff or spaghetti straps. Women may wear below-the-knee Capri pants, slacks or skirts that fall below the knee. Pilgrims will not be admitted inside the building if they violate the dress code. You will want to wear comfortable walking shoes, bring sunglasses, sun hat and dress for summer weather.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Tour prices: All prices in this brochure are based on airfares, land rates and exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on group rates of 30 passengers or more. Tours may depart with less than the required number of passengers, at the discretion of Group IST, LLC (doing business and referred to herein as "Regina Tours"), but an additional charge may apply. Passengers will be advised about such surcharges 60 days before departure. All prices are subject to change, without notice prior to departure due to major currency fluctuations, changes in fuel prices and/or unforeseen economic circumstances.

Reservations, Deposits and Final Payments: Please complete the Participant Agreement, with full names as they appear on passports, and mail it to us with the required per person deposit plus applicable (optional) insurance. Receipt of your deposit shall act as your agreement to these terms and conditions. Balance is due 60 days before departure date. If final payment is received less than 60 days, a late fee will be assessed in the amount of \$50.00. If final payment is made by credit card (American Express, Visa, MasterCard), Regina Tours requires a completed credit card authorization form. All payments made by check should be made payable to Regina Tours.

Late Reservations: If a booking is made within 60 days of departure, full payment plus applicable taxes and optional insurance is due at the time of booking. There will be a \$50.00 late processing fee applicable plus cost of any express or overnight mail services. No personal checks will be accepted with reservations received 30 days or less before departure date. Money order, bank check, certified check or credit cards (American Express, Visa, and MasterCard) will be accepted.

Travel Documents: A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Visa is required for US passport holders traveling to some destinations; please contact our office for details. All non-US citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry visa requirements pertaining to their trip. In addition non-US citizens are responsible for complying with requirements for re-entry into the USA. Regina Tours assumes no responsibility for procurement of passport or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. Regina Tours will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation.

Final Documents and Tickets: All documents and tickets are only issued upon receipt of final payment and are sent within 3 weeks of departure. Documents and tickets are not guaranteed if final payment and booking form are not received on time.

Air from Home City: All departures are based on a Little Rock airport. Regina Tours can help arrange air transportation from your home city airport. Regina Tours is not responsible for any penalties incurred on domestic tickets not purchased from us, in case of changes in the schedule of the tour. If you are making your own domestic airline tickets, please make sure that your domestic flight time arrives at least 4 hours prior to your international departure time.

Air Changes, Cancellations & Refunds: Airline tickets issued by Regina Tours are highly restrictive and in most instances cannot be reissued, revalidated or exchanged. If a change is possible, a \$75 per person administrative fee, plus any applicable airline change fees, will be assessed once air tickets have been issued. Airline penalties vary depending on carrier.

Airline Seat Assignments and Special Services: There is no advance seat selection. Early check-in is necessary to secure seats with travel companions. Seating is solely under control of the airlines. Some airlines used may be eligible for frequent flyer mileage.

Baggage: The company is not responsible for any additional charges collected by the carriers at the airport for luggage fees. We recommend that you take along one suitcase per person with a maximum weight of 50lbs., plus one carry on with maximum dimensions of 9"X14"X22". Airlines also have their own baggage restrictions; please check with the air carrier prior to your departure. All baggage is the passenger's responsibility throughout the tour. Regina Tours is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to your baggage. If a bag is lost or damaged in-flight, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly.

Airline Clause: The airlines concerned will not be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time passengers are not aboard their aircraft. The passenger tickets in use by the airline when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between airline and the purchaser of these tickets and/or passenger. These tours may be sold in connection with the services of any ATC or IATA Airline.

Rooms: Prices shown in the brochure are per person, based on two persons sharing a hotel room or cabin. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement shown per tour. In some cases, when requested, we may be able to find an appropriate roommate for passengers who have booked as a single person. If a roommate is not available, you must pay the single room supplement. While single rooms provide privacy they are often smaller than twin bedrooms. Triple rooms are available in many hotels for family or friends traveling together. There are no discounts for triple rooms.

Medical Conditions: While we endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers, we cannot guarantee special facilities or assistance for disabled passengers and it is your responsibility to arrange for such assistance as required. We regret that we cannot provide individual assistance. Regina Tours is not responsible for any medical conditions that may occur prior, during, or after the tour.

Land Only Bookings & Tour Deviations: All Regina Tours packages include airfare from the city designated. Land only bookings will be invoiced based on adjusted price. Arrival and departure transfers are not provided for land only bookings. Any deviations from the tour, requested by the client, will be assessed a charge of \$100.00 per person, plus any additional costs the change may incur.

Responsibility: The tour member understands that he or she has no claim against Regina Tours, and its affiliates, for any delay or damage to or loss of property or baggage or injury to or death of persons due to any neglect or willful act of a direct air carrier, hotel, bus company, steamship or cruise company, railroad, transportation company or service company of any kind, or any other person or persons rendering any of the services being offered in connections with these tours. Further, Regina Tours advises that it has no ownership interest whatsoever in any hotel, restaurant, bus company or transportation or service company of any kind outside the USA, nor does it have any employee outside of the USA. You

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Cancellation Policy and Refunds: We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your Regina Tours pilgrimage. However, should you need to cancel, your cancellation must be received in writing, via email, fax or by letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. If you cancel your tour after you have received your documents and airline tickets, you must return them to Regina Tours before we can process your refund. The following cancellations fees are only for fixed departure date tours published in our brochure. Fees for custom groups and tours may be different, please contact us for details. You are responsible for the cost of any non-refundable airline tickets that have been issued on your behalf plus the following cancellation charges per person:

If we canceled: We reserve the right to cancel a specific departure date or whole tour due to lack of participation or for reasons beyond our control such as natural disasters, acts of war, acts of God or government restrictions. If such an unlikely event should occur, we will offer an alternate departure date or tour program. Should you decline an alternate date or should we cancel the tour outright, the limit of our liability to you will be the refund of all monies received, including any cancellation penalties. We will not be liable, however, for costs incurred by you not paid to us, such as visas and passport costs, items of a personal nature, domestic transportation either by ground or air etc. nor will we be liable for any psychological damages, traumas, stress, disappointment, personal and financial loss resulting from our change of departure date or cancellation of a tour. Refunds are not provided for services included, but not used on a trip.

Not Included in the Published Price: Items of personal nature, excess luggage allowance, laundry, room service, travel insurance, passport and visas costs, shore excursions, expenses for additional sightseeing not specified in the itinerary, any incurred medical costs and replacement of items forgotten or stolen while on the tour, and gratuities (a list of suggested tips will be provided with final documents).

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Important: For security reasons, and due to the measures taken by the authorities, airlines require that the passenger's name in the air reservations must exactly match the name as it appears on the passport. Regina Tours is not responsible for denied boarding or re-issue costs due to an incorrect name supplied to us. Regina Tours requests a copy of your passport picture page to ensure correct name on tickets and documents.
